Dear families.

We are excited to announce that iPads have been delivered to our classroom, and will start coming home daily this coming Monday Oct. 5th!

PLEASE TAKE NOTE of these important rules concerning the iPads:

- 1) The iPads MUST go home and come back DAILY in the purple plastic bag that holds your child's library books. The purple bag is to help prevent the iPad from getting water damaged. DAILY, so that we are prepared in case of a school shutdown to continue learning virtually, and so that they can get charged.
- 2) The iPads MUST get charged at night with the included charger so they are ready for use at school the next day.
- 3) The iPads/chargers are CHECKED OUT to your student. They are like a library book in that they will be accounted for at the end of the year.
- 4) We will be supplementing our instruction with the iPads on a regular basis at school. This is so that if we ever move to virtual instruction, each student will be well versed in using each of the apps we would use. This is also why we need them charged each evening.
- 5) Please send in a pair of labeled headphones with your child so when we are using the iPads we are less likely to distract others.

We are teaching proper usage and handling of the iPads here at school, as well as necessary applications. We are grateful for your support in helping charge the iPads at home and sending them back daily.
